Required PPE



Nearest Defib(s)

- On stand
- T4 Drop Off-Pick Up Area – Terminal Building (at the head of stand 217)

Fire Assembly Point

- Head of Stand 216
- T1 Equipment Area, on East Circular Road



Safe walking routes



T1 Baggage Area
Exit the T1 Baggage Area and follow the safe walking route on the pavement opposite Stand 209. Continue walking along this route until you reach the pavement in front of Stand 213. Then, turn right and follow the walking route underneath the baggage area until you reach the T2 main baggage area, where a crossing will provide access to the KAD site.

Terminal Building
Go to Gates A1-A5, exit the building on T2 Road East and follow the signs to the event.

In The Event of Fire

REPORT
Call APOC on **0208 759 1212** (from any mobile phone) or **222** (Internal), state "Fire" and give precise location.

ACT
Try to put out fire **ONLY** if safe and trained to do so.

EVACUATE
Use the quickest fire exit route to the designated Assembly Point following the emergency exit signs. Evacuate in an orderly manner and proceed to the nearest Assembly Point. Heathrow Airside Staff will assist the evacuation procedure by guiding all visitors to the assigned assembly point and will assist the Fire Service.

Safe walking routes (from Cambridge Building)



Cambridge Building

Follow the safe walking route to Terminal 2 Building. Walk along the building on the pavement, then turn left when you reach the roundabout near stand 221. Continue walking until you reach the Drop Off-Pick Up areas. From there, follow the signs to the event.

Terminal Building

Go to Gates A1-A5, exit the terminal building on T2 Road East (at the head of stand 217) and follow the signs to the event.

- On Stand
- T4 Drop Off-Pick Up Area – Terminal Building (at the head of stand 217)



Fire Assembly Point

- Head of Stand 216
- T1 Equipment Area, on East Circular Road



Safe walking routes (to T1 main baggage hall)



T1 Baggage Area

Use safe walking routes within the baggage facility to reach the Baggage Display. Ensure your ID pass displays 3 and B to visit the Baggage Display. To visit the KAD site, please use the safe walking route as displayed on the map.

Cambridge Building

Follow the safe walking route to Terminal 2 Building. Walk along the building on the pavement, then turn left when you reach the roundabout near stand 221. Continue walking until you reach the Coaches Drop Off-Pick Up area. From there, follow the signs to the event.

- T1 Baggage Make up area



Fire Assembly Point

- T1 Baggage Make up area exit on Shuttle road
- T1 Equipment Area, on East Circular Road
