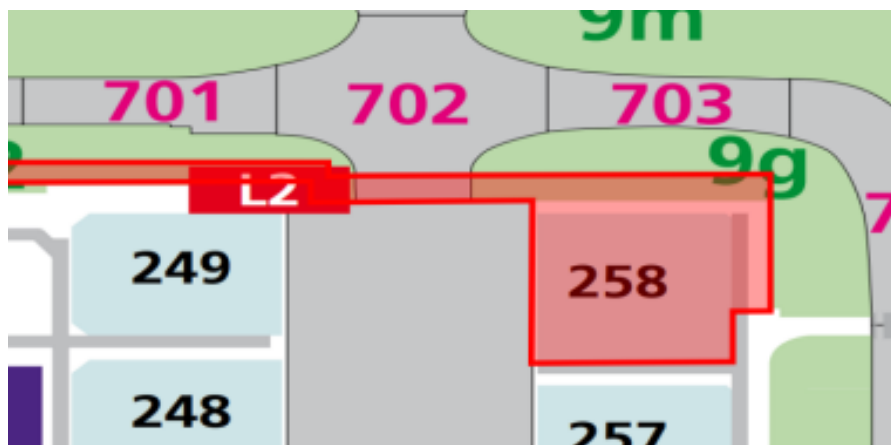
1. Introduction

On the night of the **7th February 2024**, three areas of the taxiway will be closed to allow for essential works to be carried out. When closed, the areas will not be able to be trafficked by manoeuvring area users. Each area, and the dates of the closures, are shown below.

All dates are weather dependent.

Manoeuvring area users must adhere to the closures and not transit through any worksite at any time.

Lima Taxiway – 7th February 2024 to 1st May 2024

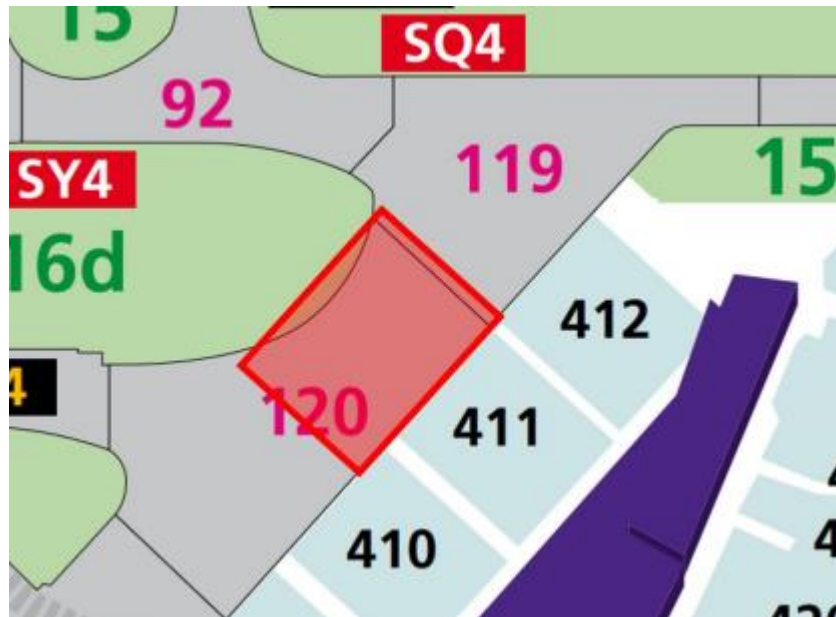


The north of Lima Taxiway (L2) will be closed 24/7 from the night of the **7th February 2024**. Stand 258 will also be closed for the duration of these works. There will be nightly closures of Bravo Taxiway, to the north of Lima Taxiway. To facilitate these works, these closures will be coned off in the usual manner.

Changes to aircraft movements from adjacent stands will be closely managed by ATC.



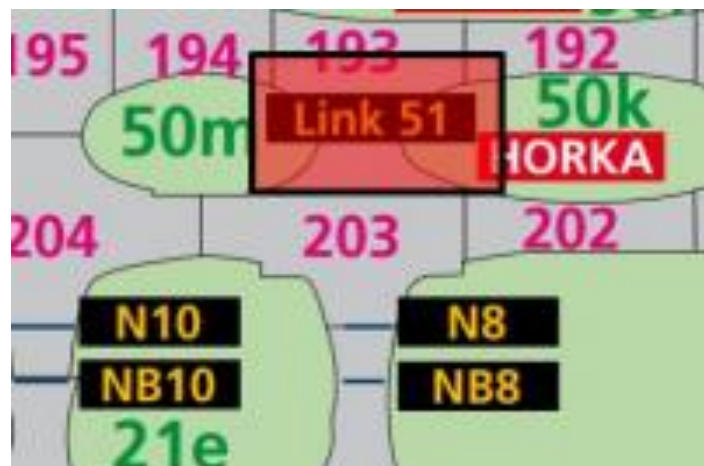
Tango Taxiway – 7th February 2024 to 7th August 2024



Tango Taxiway, adjacent to stand 411, will be closed 24/7 from the night of the 7th February 2024. Stand 411 will be fully closed to facilitate these works. Stand 410L and 410C will also be closed, 410R will be open to the operation.

Changes to aircraft movements from the adjacent stands will be closely managed by ATC.

Link 51 – 7th February 2024 to 18th April 2024



Link 51, south of T5A, will be closed 24/7 from the night of the 7th February 2024. There will be nightly closures of Bravo taxiway adjacent Link 51 to facilitate these works, these closures will be coned off in the usual manner. There are no other taxiway restrictions due to these works.
