

Airside Behaviours – Securing Airbridge Doors

Introduction

The purpose of this Safety Alert is to highlight a recent incident whereby the external doors of a passenger boarding bridge had been left open and unsecured following the use of the equipment. Airbridge operators are reminded that it is their responsibility to ensure that the equipment is left in a safe and secure state after use.

Operatives of passenger boarding bridges must:

- 1. Ensure that doors are securely closed and latched before moving the equipment and that doors are latched shut when leaving the equipment after use
- Report any faulty door locks or latches to the Heathrow Engineering Helpdesk on 0208 976 6555
