Head Injury Sustained from Guard Rail

1. Introduction

On the 24th November a ramp agent was struck on the head by the guard rail of a belt loader that they were in the process of lowering from the raised position. The guard rail was being lowered to facilitate the loading of an out-of-gauge piece of cargo into the hold of an aircraft. The ramp agent sustained a cut to the head that required hospital treatment.

- What steps can you take to ensure that colleagues are protected from being struck by moving or unsecured guard rails?
